

**LOST PINES GROUNDWATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT
NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

APPLICATION

Lower Colorado River Authority ("Applicant") has applied to the Lost Pines Groundwater Conservation District (the "District") for Operating Permits and Transfer Permits for 8 wells located in Bastrop County, Texas as follows:

- Well No. 1. Located approximately 8.9 miles northeast of the City of Bastrop and 3.9 miles southwest of the intersection of Highway 290 and Highway 21.
(30° 12' 8" N, 97° 12' 26" W)
- Well No. 2. Located approximately 8.7 miles northeast of the City of Bastrop and 3.9 miles southwest of the intersection of Highway 290 and Highway 21.
(30° 11' 47" N, 97° 12' 21" W)
- Well No. 3. Located approximately 8.1 miles northeast of the City of Bastrop and 4.3 miles southwest of the intersection of Highway 290 and Highway 21.
(30° 11' 31" N, 97° 12' 38" W)
- Well No. 4. Located approximately 7.7 miles northeast of the City of Bastrop and 4.7 miles southwest of the intersection of Highway 290 and Highway 21.
(30° 11' 15" N, 97° 12' 56" W)
- Well No. 5. Located approximately 7.4 miles northeast of the City of Bastrop and 5 miles southwest of the intersection of Highway 290 and Highway 21.
(30° 11' 2" N, 97° 13' 11" W)
- Well No. 6. Located approximately 7.1 miles northeast of the City of Bastrop and 5.3 miles southwest of the intersection of Highway 290 and Highway 21.
(30° 10' 48" N, 97° 13' 25" W)
- Well No. 7. Located approximately 6.8 miles northeast of the City of Bastrop and 5.7 miles southwest of the intersection of Highway 290 and Highway 21.
(30° 10' 34" N, 97° 13' 41" W)
- Well No. 8. Located approximately 6.4 miles northeast of the City of Bastrop and 6.1 miles southwest of the intersection of Highway 290 and Highway 21.
(30° 10' 19" N, 97° 13' 57" W)

The Applicant proposes to complete the wells in the Simsboro Aquifer and to withdraw an aggregate of 25,000 acre-feet of water per year from the 8 wells to be used for municipal, industrial, recreational, irrigation, and agricultural purposes in the LCRA Water Service Area. The 8 wells will pump at an aggregated instantaneous rate of 18,000 gallons per minute.
